Job Summary: Southwest Texas College seeks a Face-to-Face and Asynchronous Mathematics Instructor to teach freshmen and sophomore-level courses. Duties include teaching face-to-face courses during the day and evening, as well as asynchronous courses; recruiting and advising students; and serving on committees. Candidates must demonstrate knowledge of online delivery methods and course development, the ability to work effectively both independently and collaboratively, a strong student-centered approach, and the capacity to meet deadlines while maintaining accurate and complete course records. Experience with Canvas LMS is preferred. Additional responsibilities include developing and updating curriculum, syllabi, and instructional materials. Assignments may include dual credit courses, and travel to other SWTX college sites may be required.

Classification: Full-time, exempt

Department: Arts and Science

Salary: Salary is commensurate with education and experience, based on the SWTX college salary schedule. This is a nine-month, non-tenure track faculty position.

Must enjoy meeting the public and assisting students. Must possess required knowledge, skills, abilities, and experience and be able to explain and demonstrate, with or without reasonable accommodations, the essential functions of the job. Experience in working with diverse populations. Candidate must be authorized to work in the U.S. and must provide verifiable credentials; successful completion of background and reference check specified for the position. Must have a valid Driver's License and be insurable through SWTX insurers. Travel required to other geographic locations served by the college.
